
The tables presented below gives the gender ratio both in count and in percentages for the past 5 years from 2017-18 to 2021-2022.




2. Gender classification of student academic year 2018-2019.




3.Gender classification of student academic year 2019-2020.




4. Gender classification of student academic year 2020-2021.




5. Gender classification of student academic year 2021-2022.




6. Year wise Gender classification of Teaching Staff 2017-2018 to 2021-2022.
